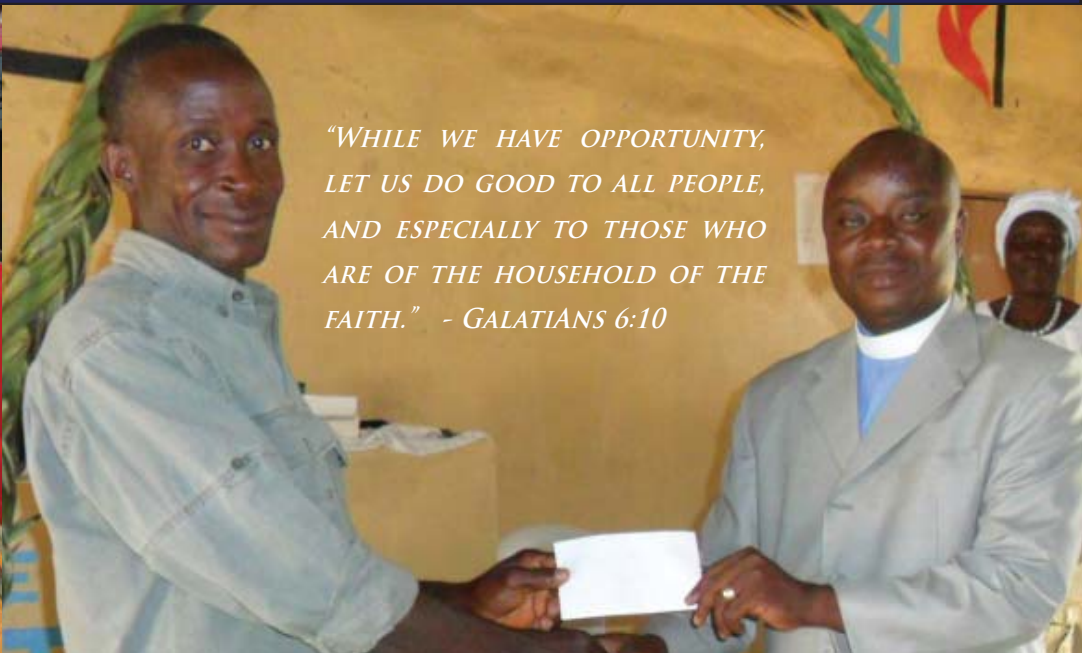

After receiving this email and knowing that these pastors continued to serve faithfully in the midst of great danger, Ramesh Richard felt a burden to address some of the physical and financial needs of these pastors under RREACH's Pastor's Family Care Fund. Because of your generosity and the Lord's faithfulness, we were able to send **\$13,958** to our contacts in Liberia. Pastor K and Pastor P (Dallas GPA 2007 graduate) distributed these funds to **69** pastors and their families. The funds were sufficient to provide food, medicine and a Christmas gift to each family, as well as small cash gifts for Pastor K and Pastor P, our project managers.
